

5 TBI Truths

While many people know about the risks of sports-related traumatic brain injuries (TBI), some might be surprised to learn about how common a risk they are to a wide range of the population. Consider:

- Nearly three million Americans sustain a traumatic brain injury (TBI) each year in the United States.
- **2.** Yes, even a "mild" concussion is clinically considered a traumatic brain injury.
- **3.** Falls are responsible for nearly half of all TBI-related hospitalizations.
- 4. Three other common TBI causes include firearm-related injuries, motor vehicle crashes, and assaults.
- There are more than 175 deaths attributed to TBI per day in the United States.
- **6.** Early detection and intervention for suspected TBI is critical, especially to young developing brains.



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
