More than 3 million people sustain a brain injury each year in the United States. Here are 4 things to know:

- Acquired brain injuries (ABIs) are those that do not involve a congenital, degenerative, hereditary, or birth-induced trauma.
- Some lesser-discussed sources of ABI include substance abuse/overdose, infectious diseases, and toxic exposure.
- Falls account for nearly half of all leading causes of traumatic brain injury, or TBI.
- One out of 60 Americans lives with a disability related to a TBI.
